- Carpentry framing of the roof & setting trusses and finish carpentry of trim and setting cabinets

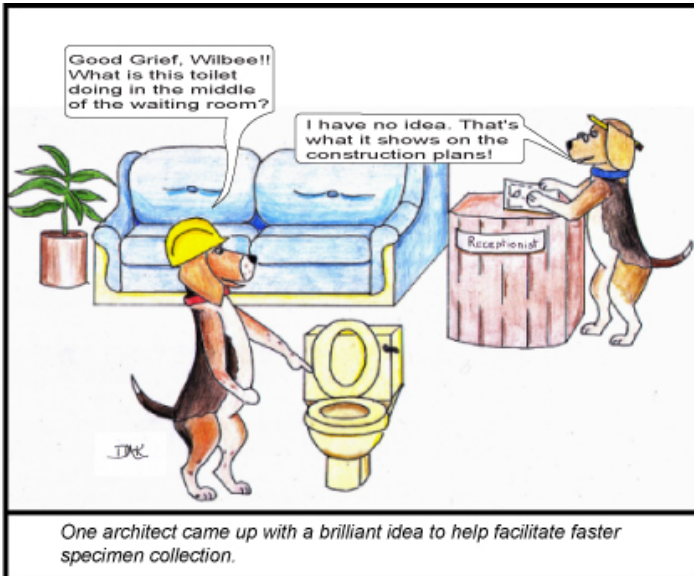


In November of 2008 we received a certificate of commendation for an excellent safety record from AGC recognizing our zero incident rate since 2005

The National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) program is an ongoing effort to offer AGC members an opportunity to evaluate their safety record. NASA compares a member's safety record with other AGC members according to the member size and construction type.

To receive the certificate of commendation for an excellent safety record the company must be a member of AGC, participate in the national AGC safety awards program for three consecutive years, and have an incident rate 25% lower than the other members of the building division rate.

Zero incidents means just that. Your company must have no accidents as major as deaths, falls, etc., or as minor as cuts, scrapes, etc., including no employee lost time due to above incidents and injuries.
